HIGHLIGHTS

- The meeting was called to order at 9:00 am with a word of prayer led by Rev. Longisa
- Thereafter, the vice chairperson welcomed the members and a self –introduction by all members followed.

- Minutes of the Rumuruti full municipal board meeting held on 24th May, 2025 were read to the members and Ms. Ann Munyi confirmed that they were a true reflection of the previous meeting. The confirmation was seconded by Mr. Fredrick Mwangi Njuguna.

- Members deliberated on and approved the 2025/2026 annual urban Investment plan considering public input submitted during the public participation forum held on 7th April, 2025 as prioritized below:

- a. Procurement of a Fire engine
- b. Construction of Rumuruti Market
- c. Upgrading of Rumuruti town roads
- d. Installation of Street lights
- e. Construction of Rumuruti Municipal social hall
- f. Construction of a modern Recreational park
- g. Construction of Boda boda sheds
- h. Construction of a rescue center

- Flooding within the municipality areas due to inadequate drainage is a key concern.

The following critical locations require culverts construction.

1. Ngomongo feeder roads (grading and gravelling)
2. Culvert at the Route Hotel towards Kiambiriria
3. The Rumuruti day towards Manyatta - (gravelling and culvert construction)
4. Culvert construction opposite The Shepherd hotel.
5. Culvert installation along Fiesta Warma road.
6. Kiambiriria corner culvert construction
7. The Route-Kiambiriria Road is in poor condition and requires urgent grading.
